



Code of Conduct for Young People in EYO

The Ealing Youth Orchestra is committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. All young people involved in EYO activities should follow the Code of Conduct.

Members are asked:

- To treat everyone with respect regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, sexual orientation or religious belief
- To act as a good role model with appropriate behaviour
- To be supportive and committed to other members
- To be friendly and particularly welcoming to new members
- To attend rehearsals and performances on time wearing correct clothing
- To inform the Music Director if going to be late to, or be absent from, events
- To obey all reasonable instructions or requests from the Music Director, other adults in authority and leaders
- To take care of equipment and help to set it up and put it away when needed
- To look after the environment
- Not to be involved in inappropriate peer pressure and bullying in person or via social media. Social media use must be considered and thoughtful and never used to criticise or bully other members. Remember the golden rule: never write or post anything to or about an individual that you would not be prepared to say to them in person.
- Not to consume alcohol while with EYO and representing the orchestra. Smoking is prohibited in and around rehearsal and performance venues. Drugs of any kind are strictly forbidden at all times.
